ACTIVITIES FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY 2021

1. Online classes resumed after winter break: 04th January, 2021

The school resumed its online classes after winter break on 04th January, 2021 for the students of classes I to XII. A special morning assembly was conducted through virtual platform, seeking God's blessings for the smooth running of the school during this pandemic time. Prayers and petitions were held to help the management, staff, students and their families, feel excitement and joy in the promise of a new start.

2. The new normal- Online classes: 06th January, 2021

An online webinar was organized by The Times of India (NIE) on 06th January, 2021. The topic for the session was 'Analysis of Sociological and Psychological factors affecting Students and Teachers due to online classes'. The main speakers were Mr. Tarun Anand (Chairman and Founder- Universal Business School) and Dr. Preeti Das (Additional Director of the United World school of Liberal Arts and Mass Communication at Karnavati University).
