8. UNICEF conducts WEBINAR: 29th July, 2020

A webinar was conducted by UNICEF representatives along with NCC and Forest Department, Rajasthan on 29thJuly, 2020. There were around 1290 NCC cadets from all over the state participating in the webinar. Mr. Arjun Singh, NCC speaker talked about the importance of NCC and how NCC cadets can help in the situation of Covid-19. Mr. Rajeev Sharma, Director of Rajasthan Police Academy and Child care protection addressed the cadets and informed everyone about his newsletter named SETU. He also talked about his operation MUSKAAN, initiated to reunite missing children with their families. He made everyone aware of certain issues concerned to children during this lockdown like financial issues, increase in digital activities, lack of gadgets for education, sexual exploitation rising online etc. He told about how we can resolve these issues by increasing awareness. The session was followed by a short animated film which was based on how we can help others during this hard time by taking precautions, providing them food, basic necessities, and making them aware about this pandemic and government policies. Then, a quiz was conducted on this topic by Mrs. Maniree Pant who is a member of Gujarat and Rajasthan UNICEF committee, and works for welfare of children and their health services. The session continued with a presentation by Mr. Sanjay Neerala, who has been working for children for the past 15 years. He is also a member of Rajasthan UNICEF. He made us aware about child abuse and how to create awareness among children regarding such issues. Then he answered to some questions related to this and informed the cadets about various helplines. This was followed by a presentation by Ms. Evangeline Manohar who is a consultant for psycho-social support. She made us aware about the importance of the same. She talked about the symptoms, how to identify if someone needs support, what to do and about some helplines working towards this motive. The session proved to be very helpful in creating awareness among cadets regarding such intense issues from our society.
