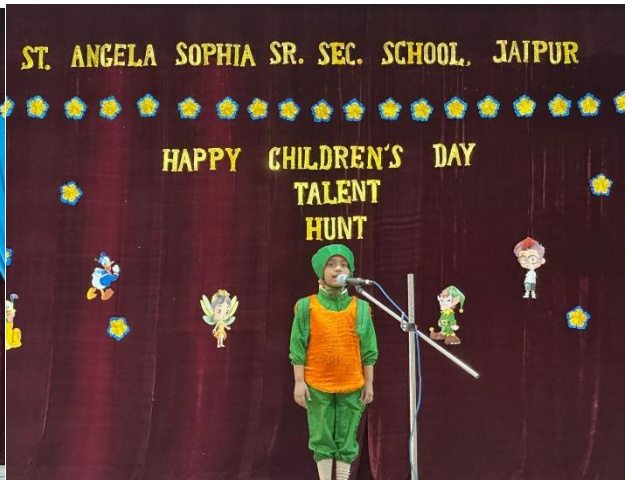
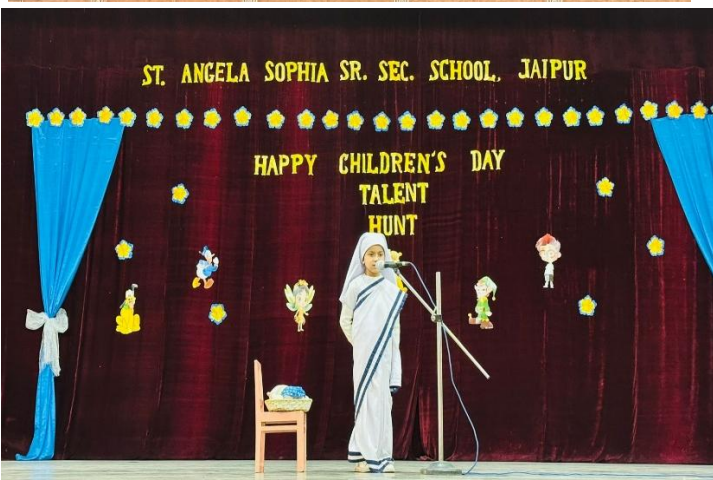
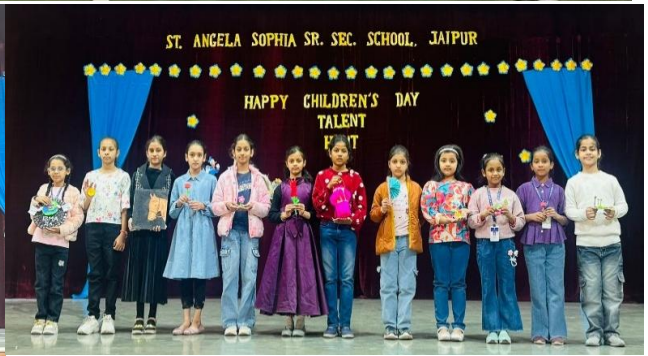
scenic views, and various recreational activities. The picnic was filled with laughter, music, and memorable moments.
